

# Director - IT Transformation & DevOps

## Position Summary

The Director - IT Transformation & DevOps at Farmer Mac will be responsible for Digital Transformation within the IT function including the associated people, processes, and technology to better align with the strategic plan of the enterprise. The position identifies, develops and implements near- and long-term strategies relating to the development of new products, technologies, and services that support the enterprise. The position ensures solutions are designed in a manner that considers customer experience, current and future state architectures, addresses cross-functional and cross-system implications, adheres to enterprise architecture principles and standards, and accounts for existing and emerging technologies, and security requirements.

The ideal candidate must have management and leadership experience and a proven ability to deliver strategically aligned and revenue-enabling IT services based on a risk management framework, as well as extensive experience interfacing with executive management and experience in managing corporate or business-unit level IT or Digital Transformation functions. The candidate should preferably have financial services industry experience.

## Who You Will Work With

Reporting to the VP - Operations & Technology and working in close coordination with the Director - Operations, the Director – IT Transformation & DevOps will have responsibility for aligning business objectives to IT strategy and roadmaps. The position will manage a team of IT professionals, including, database developers, project managers, and software engineers in headquarters as well as in remote offices.

## Where and When You Will Work

The position will be based in Farmer Mac's headquarters located at 1999 K Street NW, Washington, DC. Core business hours are Monday through Friday 8:30 am to 5:30 p.m. eastern time. Work outside of these times may be required for planned and unplanned activities to complete time-sensitive projects or to attend off-site meetings or events. Periodic travel is expected of this position.

## Primary Responsibilities and Duties

- Provide strategic thought leadership and guide IT strategic initiatives and IT transformation activities across Farmer Mac
- Develop IT Transformation initiatives that are aligned with Farmer Mac's strategic plan
- Promote the organization's corporate values and strategic vision
- Support business objectives and goals, define the ways in which technology can enable them, establish the business case, and translate into a multi-year strategy and project roadmap that reflects business priorities
- Manage and oversee the delivery of projects necessary to execute on the defined strategies. This includes supporting requirements gathering, business case development, technology selection, project management, implementation, end user adoption and governance
- Provide strategic leadership and creative thinking tied to the analysis of technology trends and the identification of new opportunities to help drive growth strategies
- Be accountable for transformative design, deployment, and integrated delivery of major enterprise platforms
- Build and present business cases for digital initiatives based on industry trends, business needs, and scalable growth. This includes the implementation of strategic platforms and solutions
- Offer input for developing and implementing the organization's digital strategy and integrating digital into all aspects of the business (e.g., content, channels, processes, and operating models)
- Assess and identify emerging developments in digital technology, e-business platforms, digital and mobile products/services, customer behavior, and partnerships in line with Farmer Mac's digital strategy
- Manage a portfolio of in-house developed systems and support their transition to cloud based technologies
- Manage a highly qualified and motivated team. Responsible for all mentoring, development, and evaluation of a team of talented IT professionals, including database developers and software engineers
- Direct and manage the design, development, testing of all software systems, including external and internal business processing systems
- Benchmark, analyze, and make recommendations for the continual improvement of the IT tactical and strategic applications, data, infrastructure, platforms, and overall systems
- Scale the organization by mentoring and designating select engineers as "Technical Leads" and delegate to them the work of guiding the technical direction of an increasing number of projects.
- Liaison with cross-functional teams from across the enterprise
- Present IT transformation plans to a variety of stakeholders including board members, executive leadership, staff, business partners, and audit groups

- Strong understanding of enterprise data governance strategy
