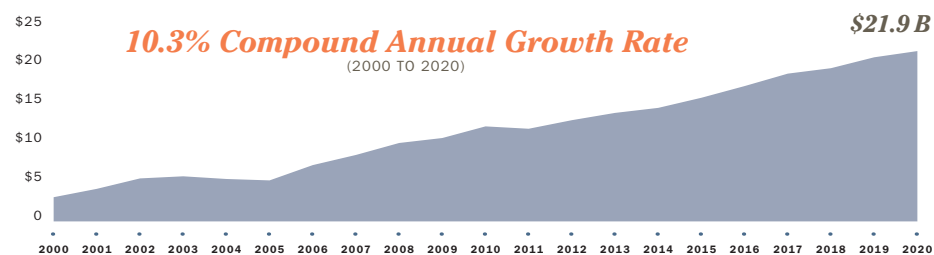

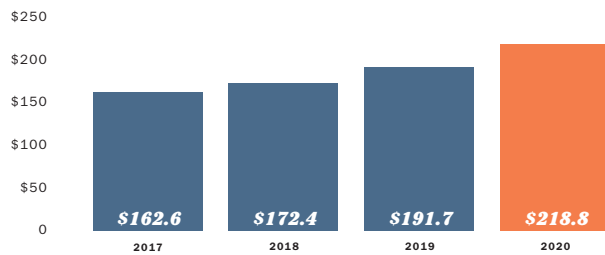

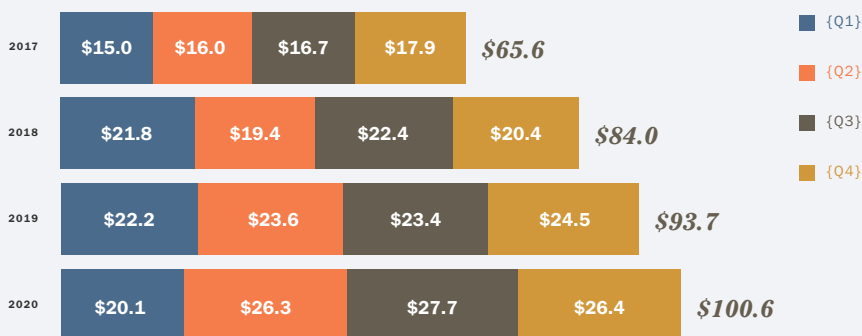

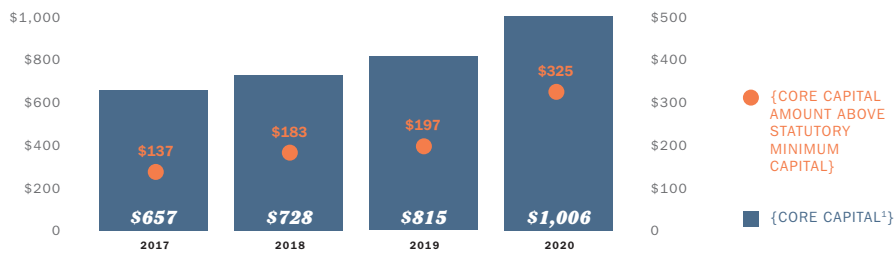
REVENUE \$ in millions
