

### Highlight 1: Tariffs, Tariffs, Tariffs



#### Highlight 2: Land Values Holding (Mostly)

• USDA's annual land value survey shows cropland average up 0.98%, total farm real estate up 1.95% from June 2017 to June 2018

• Upper plains show decreases in average reported farm real estate values



% Change in Farm Real Estate Value / Acre: <-2.0%

-2.0%-0.0% 0.0%-2.0% > 2.0%



#### Highlight 3: LIBOR Sunset


- London Interbank Offered Rate is on its way out (banks no longer required to submit rates starting in 2021)
- Tons and tons and tons of financial instruments are priced to the index
- Most notes/mortgages/instruments contain an index switch clause; leading candidate right now is Secured Overnight Financing Rate (SOFR)

#### Loans Indexed to USD LIBOR Rates



- Drought persists in Southwest
- East coast very wet (Florence/summer storms)
- Southern plains helped by summer moisture



- Big soybean crop coming, harvest is happening quickly
- Good demand, both foreign and domestic
- Cash prices plummeted in August on expectations of big crop and a doublingdown of trade tensions with China
